

Gain access to tools, ideas, and processes that can be adapted to your own work.

What sort of initiatives are we talking about?

- ✓ **Data portals** to inform citizens about ✓ **E-procurement** to reduce corruption the amount of funds allocated to schools
- ✓ Online platforms to report informal payments made by parents to schools
- ✓ **Satellite systems** to control the location and building of schools
- ✓ Mobile phone apps & chatbots to check the quantity and quality of textbooks or school meals.
- ✓ **Electronic cards** to monitor the identity or presence of staff

- risks in the procurement of school purchases
- ✓ Cameras to monitor exams and avoid cheating
- ✓ Websites to inform students about non-accredited education institutions or diploma mills
- ✓ Social media to report cases of corruption in schools or universities
- ✓ Artificial intelligence to carry out automated audits and monitor public spending in schools






